



Application fee

Applicants with foreign qualifications must include a non-refundable application fee of 100 euro. Applications will not be considered without the required fee.

In certain specific situations payment of the application fee is not required. These situations are indicated below.

Payment of the application fee is not required for:

- Prospective **Master's** students who want to apply for:
 - Animal Welfare
 - Conflict and Security Law
 - Epidemiology Postgraduate
 - International Business Law and Globalisation
 - International Law of Human Rights and Criminal Justice
 - Veterinary Epidemiology and Economics
 - Veterinary and Molecular Pathology

- Prospective **Master's** students who want to apply for the Netherlands Fellowship Programme (December 1 deadline only)
- Prospective **Bachelor's** students with a diploma originating from an EU/EEA country, a VWO diploma from the Dutch Antilles or Surinam, or a Maturitätszeugnis from Switzerland.
- Prospective **Bachelor's** students who have obtained an International or European Baccalaureate diploma
- students with Dutch qualifications
- exchange students registered at Utrecht University
- students with refugee status in the Netherlands

The fee can be paid by credit card or by bank transfer into the ABN AMRO bank account of Utrecht University. Do not send cash.
